



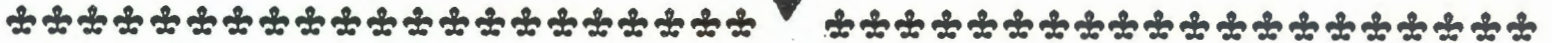

This years Conclave is being sponsored by our own Sipp-O Lodge at Camp Tuscazoar on the weekend of April 30 thru May 2, 1982. It promises to be the most exciting and enjoyable Conclave that has been put on in recent years.

Starting it off on Friday night will be a Brotherhood Ceremony put on by members of Marnoc Lodge of Akron. Saturday morning will feature workshops dealing with various lodge functions highlighted by an Indian Crafts session where you can make Indian Ceremonial or Dance items.

Saturday afternoon will have inter-Lodge competitions such as a pie eating contest, and a tug-of-war, just to name two. There will also be special events for your entertainment.
