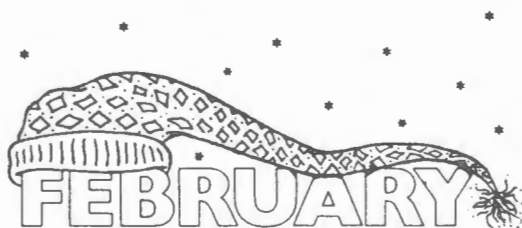


ANNUAL BANQUET A SUCCESS

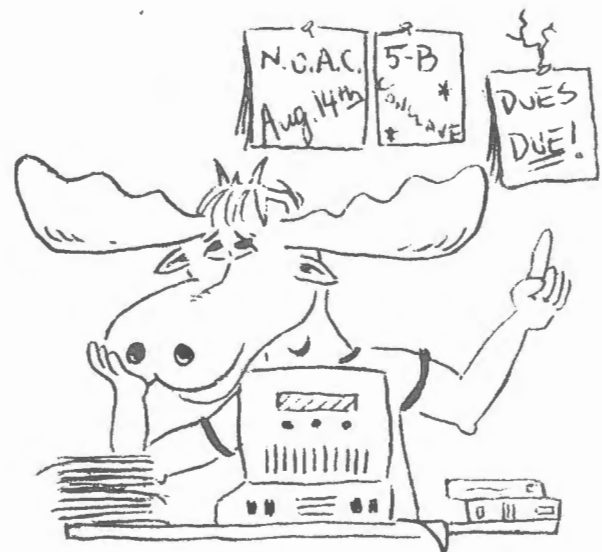

ARE YOUR DUES IN?

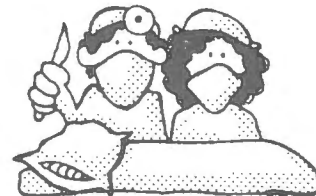

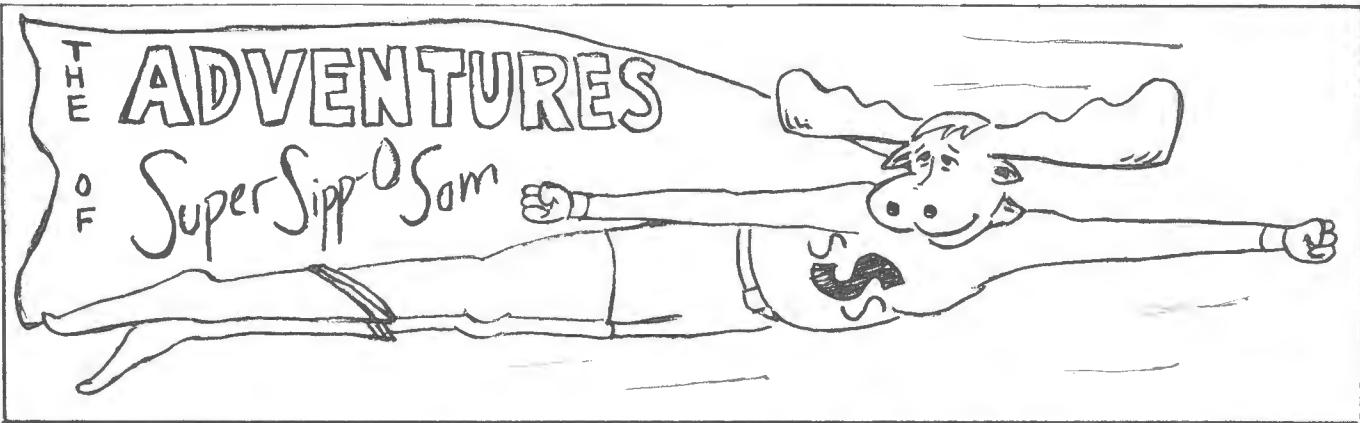
