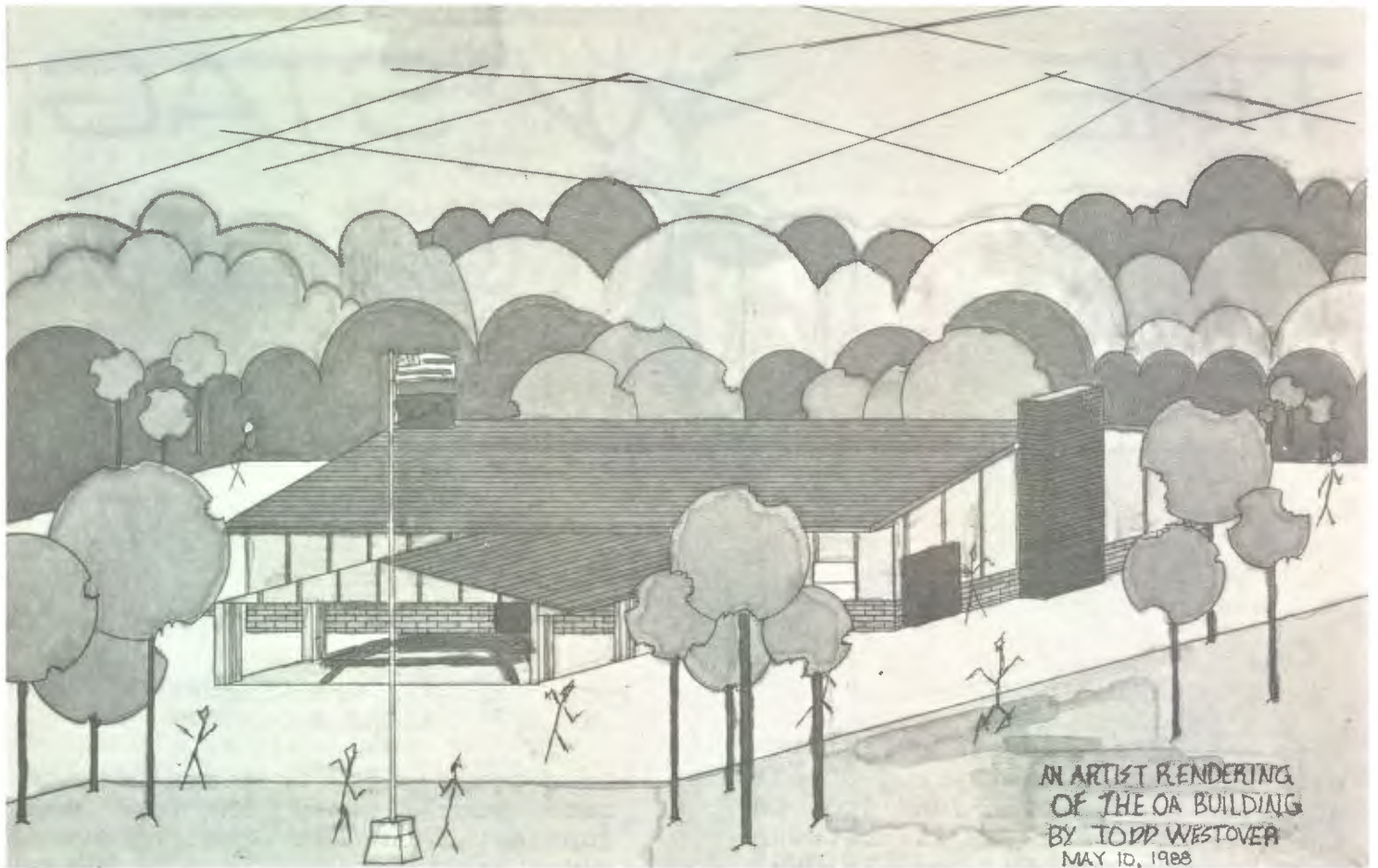
The balance of \$175.00 is due at the council office by JUNE 1ST. Don't miss it, act now.

**SIPP-O LONGHOUSE
COMING SOON**

Sipp-O Lodge has been presented with a great opportunity, as well as a big challenge. We have been authorized to raise funds and materials to construct an Order of the Arrow multi-purpose building at Seven Ranges Scout Reservation. The Sipp-O Longhouse, as it will be called, will be 32'X 64' with a 20'X 32' porch facing the north end of the lake. It will seat 185 persons, with sleeping for 112. The building will provide kitchen, storage, and restroom/shower facilities for our functions at camp, and can be rented out to other Scouting groups.

This project needs your support to make it a reality. It can be constructed for an estimated \$40,000 in cash or materials. In order to break ground, we must have \$12,000 in cash. As this is a Sipp-O Lodge project, all monies and material must come from lodge members. We need your help!!

Our fund drive is running from now until June 30, 1988. All members who donate will receive a certificate of appreciation. Those persons who donate \$20.00 or more will have their names placed on an honor roll which will hang in the new building.
