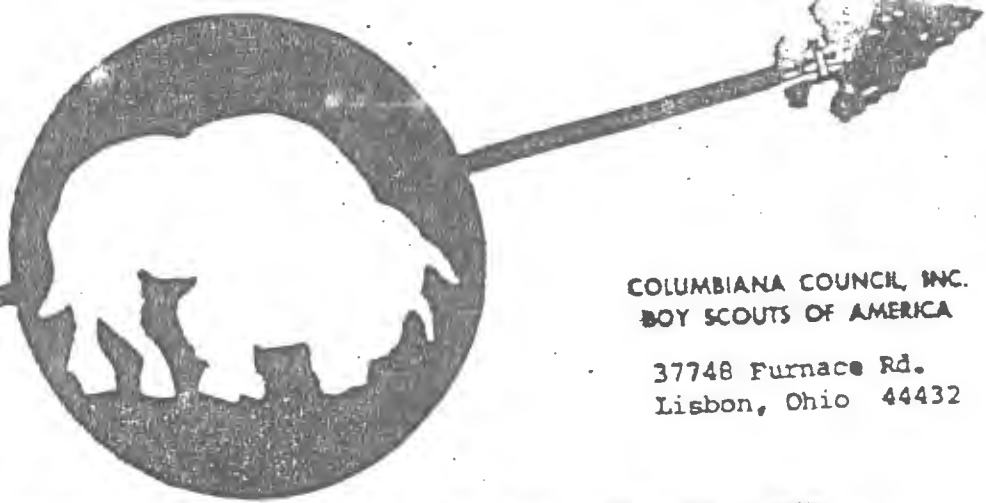

The following is the suggestion you requested to be written out in letter form. It concerns the 1990 and 1991 Lodge officer's terms of office.

Terms of office in many Lodges run from September to September. This is beneficial because it coincides with Lodge Charter renewal and because it follows the school calender. Officers (except the chief, who remains on the Executive Committee) who have graduated from High School and are going to college far from Columbiana Council would be free from the responsibility of four more mounths of Executive meetings.

The nice weather of September would make it easier for some of the older members of our Lodge to attend the Annual Banquet, and it might make it easier for the guest speaker to come.

The major advantage is lining up with our Charter Renewal, which Scaroyadii Lodge is always behind in doing.
