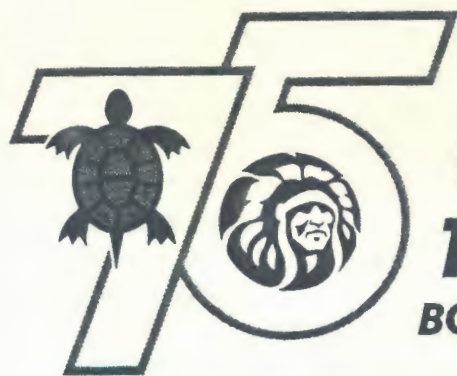
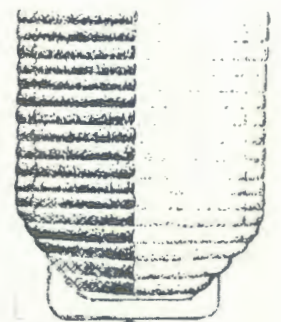

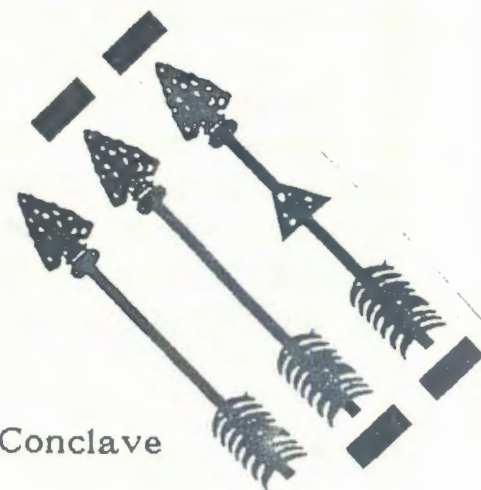

EXECUTIVE AND LODGE

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING :

3. The dance team has been invited to a dance in May. For more information, see Bob Frail.
4. The 75th Anniversary Award will cost \$2.50 per award. Motion by Jay Walther to increase the cost to \$3.00 per award to raise money for the lodge: Second by Bob Frail. Vote tally: 3 yeas, 2 nays. Motion passed.
5. Dance Team Committee Report by Chairman, Bob Frail. Bob reported that all of the costumes have been cleaned and repaired.
6. The full payment of \$185.00 for N.O.A.C '90 is due May 1, 1990. The cost will become \$210.00 if paid after this date.
7. Suggestions for fundraisers were submitted, including one of selling M&M's at the beginning of the next school year.
8. Motion to close meeting by Paul Heins: Second by Stacey Dattilio. Motion passed.

c. Brotherhood Ceremony Competition, team of 5-6 people needed to take to conclave.

d. Report on March 3rd work day given by Mr. Kloss. He reported that the new dock has been completed thanks to Monty Hill and the others that helped.

5. New Business:

a. Tod Mumpire read a letter from Tindeuchen Lodge #522 inviting Scaroyadii Lodge members to their annual banquet on March 25.

b. An idea for selling T-shirts at the conclave with a Scaroyadii Lodge design screened on it was discussed. Tod Mumpire offered to give a report on the issue at the next meeting. Motion to table the T-shirt issue by Stacey Dattilio: Second by Jon Santini. Motion passed.
