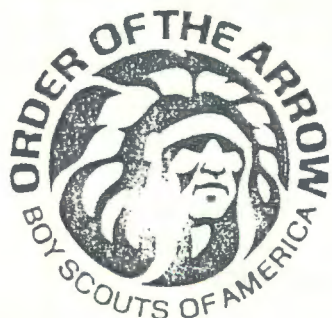
DUES
