Dear KDK,

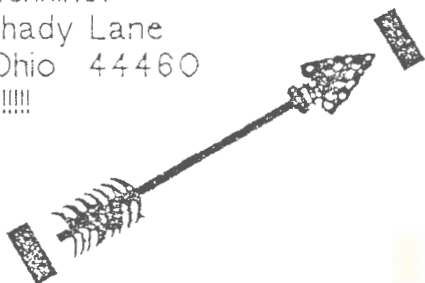

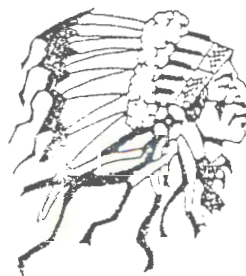


## ☺COMMITTEE DRAFT☺
