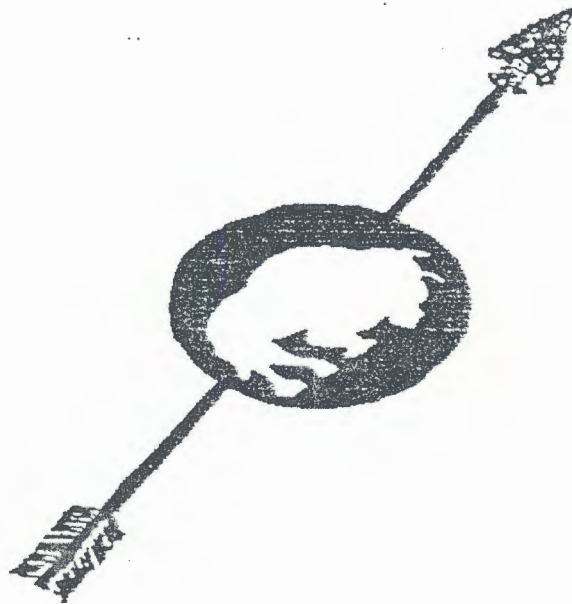

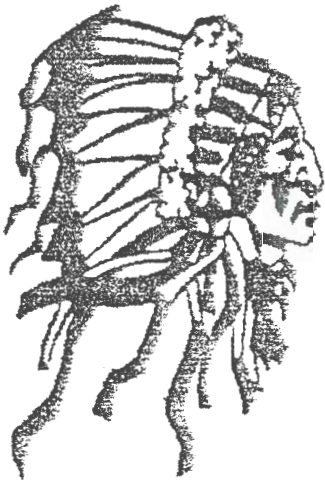

To Scott Davis who has began his first steeep in the big brother program.

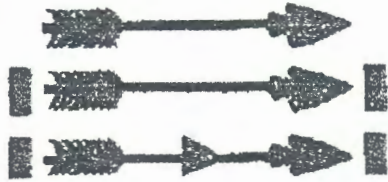
To all the lodge members who make Scaroyadii Lodge what it is today. A GREAT TIME.

DUES

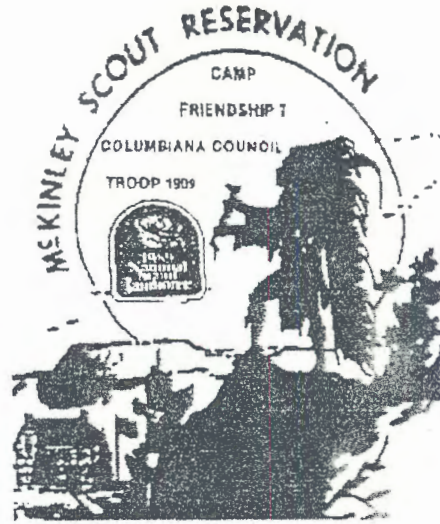
