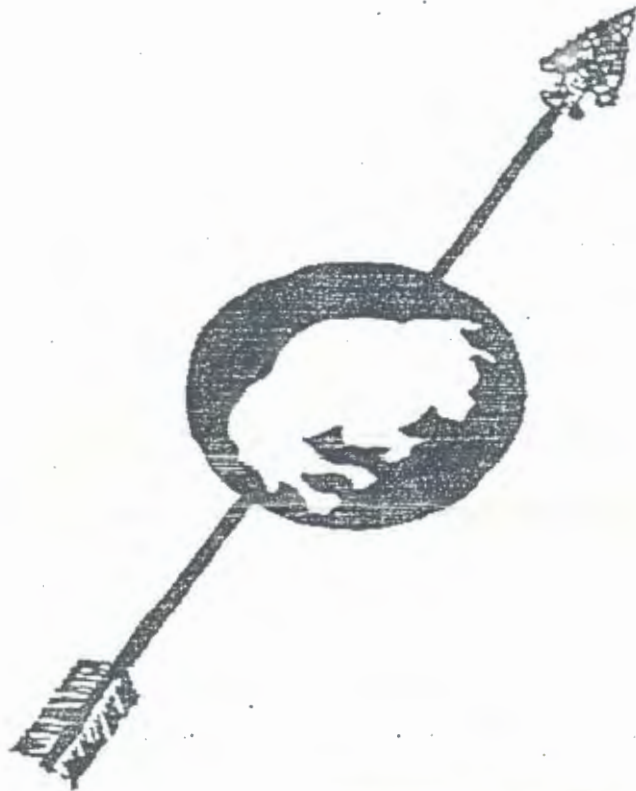

to Southern California. He says if that does not work out he'll pursue an acting career.

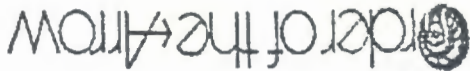
Scott is a member of the Methodist Church in Salem.

Scott has also been to several training sessions such as J.L.T. where he was on staff. He also

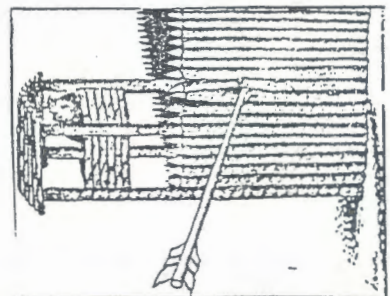
attending Den Chief training.

PATCHES!

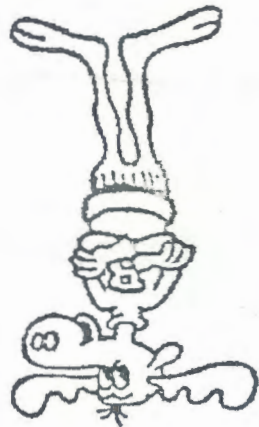

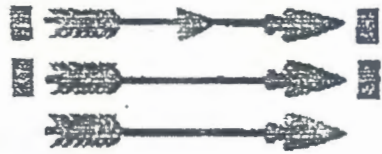

The National Order of the Arrow Conference will be held on August 9-13, 1992 in Knoxville Tennessee at the University of Tennessee. There is a payment plan set up for all members who are interested in going to N.O.A.C. 92. Look for the full page ad in this issue of the WHITE BUFFALO. The payment plan is as follows:

The National Order of the Arrow Conference is scheduled for August 9-13, 1992. The site for the conference is the University of Tennessee, Knoxville. There will be plenty to do, the Knoxville Zoo, scenic river rides, thrilling white water rafting, and Graphite Reactor (the nations first nuclear reactor), all located near the university. We sent 13 arrowmen to N.O.A.C. in 1990, lets send 50 this time. Reservations will be taken at the next meeting. The price is \$ 185.00 if received before April and \$210.00 if received after May. There is a payment plan set up for all lodge members. The first payment, \$35.00, will be taken at the next Scaroyadii Lodge meeting with this tear sheet.
