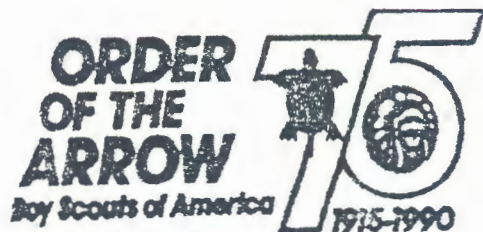
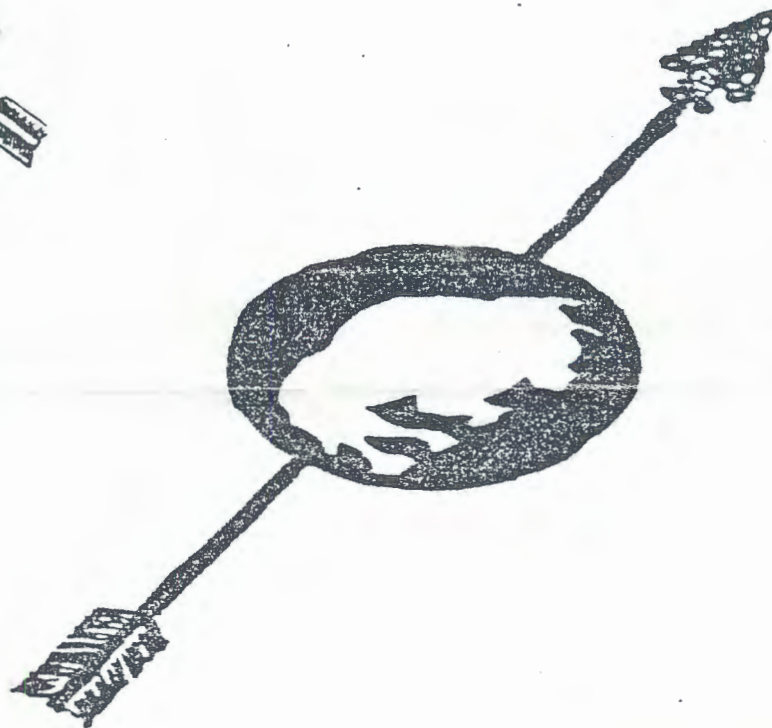

National Order of the arrow Conference is scheduled for August 9-13, 1992 and we have 14 members who will be in attendance. The contingent had special patches made and they look good.

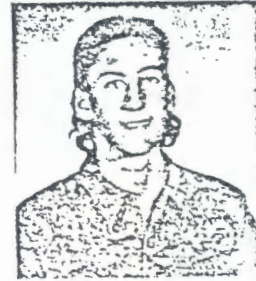

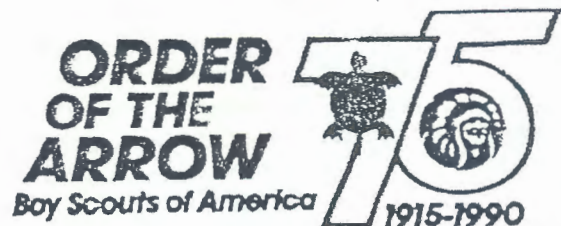
ORDEAL 92'
