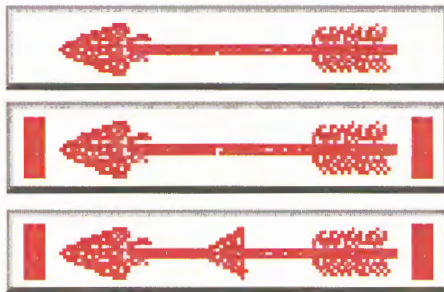

This new flap replaces the current issue, the S40, which has been worn proudly by Sipp-ites since 1994 with only minor modifications made. The S40 had been carried by our lodge members across the nation to numerous NOACs, Jamborees and other scouting events across the nation, with well over a thousand copies made.
