What better way to make a fellow Arrowman your BFF than to 'pin' him with this 1961 Sterling silver OA pin? OA pins preceded patches, being produced from the 1920's to the early 1970's but the much cheaper price of patches and ease of wear on the uniform eventually supplanted the pins in popularity. This Sipp-O example was available at the

1961 Winter Banquet as a fund-raiser. It is stamped with the 'E.J.Caldwell' hallmark and Sterling stamp. The totem plus the arrow indicates brotherhood membership. You old-timers might want to look through your jewelry chest. It may be only Sterling silver, but it's worth more than its weight in gold.
